## 7Hills 2022 Most Used rules.txt SEVEN HILLS COED SOFTBALL Updated, Reminders of Rules

- 1. In the event of a tie game after seven (7) innings, the next inning will begin with a runner placed on 2nd base.
- 2. The defensive alignment for each team shall be 2 males, 2 females in Outfield, 2 Males, 2 Females in the infield. The gender that pitches, then opposite gender shall be the catcher.

  No switching positions during the inning, unless of injury.

  One for one defensive movements, if injury does occurs.

  2.A. There is no rover fielder in the field allowed at any time!
- 3. One courtesy runner is allowed for each gender per game. Once that player has had that gender can not have another for the game, the runner is the previous genders' out in line up.
- 4. Batting line-up consists of 5 male and 5 female. Each team may bat 6 Males, 6 Females a 6th male as the DH, must bat in the 11th spot. This is the only time a team may more males than females. A team may always choose to play more females than males though. Each team may bat 6 males and 6 females or 7 males and 7 females. The line-up must be an alternating gender of M,F,M,F,etc. or F,M,F,M,etc.
- 5. There is a 4 home run limit for each team of over the fence hits.
- 6. Run rule limits are: 20 runs after 3 innings, 15 runs after 4 innings, and 10 runs after 5 innings. The home team still bats in the bottom of the inning if they are the team that is behind.(home team always gets their last at-bats, if behind)
- 7. No metal cleats are allowed
- 8. Only softball bats allowed by ASA/USA Softball are permitted for use, as per ASA rules USA.asasoftball com Non-Approved BAt List
